He	's	a journalist.
She	's	a doctor.
It	's	a book.
We	're	mechanics.
You	're	pilots.
They	're	policemen.

affirmative	negative	question
I, You, He, She, It, We, You, They can + base verb	I, You, He, She, It, We, You, They can't + base verb	Can I, you, he, she, it, we, you, they + base verb + ?

Can

modal verb

- to be **able** to do something
(poder, saber)

*Can you **drive**?*

*I **can't swim**.*

- used to **request** something
(poder)

*Can I have a **glass of water**?*

- used in **polite offers** of **help**
(poder)

*Can I **help** you with those **bags**?*

- to be **allowed** to do something

(poder)

You can't *park* here.

Can I go now?

- used to *talk* about what is *possible*

(poder)

You can get *stamps* from the *post office*.
